FIRE DRILLS--REGULATIONS

Fire drills and other drills are held to teach orderly behavior in emergencies. The special instructions must be followed without questions.

Misbehavior at such time will meet severe penalties because of the added hazard to the safety of all.

The signal is a long repeated ringing of the fire bell.

This is a separate bell from that used for changing classes. The "all clear" is the same as the signal. If this alarm should fail, the class bells will be rung repeatedly.

All students are to go out in an orderly manner, led by the teacher, and they should proceed to the designated area and remain in line.

Each teacher is to appoint a monitor in each class to make sure the room is empty and that the door is closed. Windows are to be closed, if possible, to confine the fire.

When drills are held during the passing of classes, students are to leave by the nearest exit and go to the designated area.

Fire drills may be held without notice at any time.
