

SPECIAL EDUCATION POLICY AND PURPOSE

The Kittery School Department will comply with and implement the Federal Education for All Handicapped Children Act (P.L. 94-142, 20/USC 140 et seq.), and Title 20-A, Chapters 301 and 302, as described in Chapter 101, Special Education Regulations to assure a free appropriate public education to students with disabilities who:

Have reached age five years on or before October 15;

Have not graduated from secondary school or reached 20 years of age before the start of the school year;

Have disabilities that adversely affect educational performance; and

Require the provision of special education services in order that the student may benefit from an elementary or secondary educational program.
