

EDUCATION TECHNICIANS

The Committee may employ education technicians to work under the supervision of a certified teacher. Because certification is a statutory requirement for anyone who teaches, tasks performed by education technicians must be limited to non-teaching duties. These functions may include:

Assisting individual children in need of special attention;

Performing clerical duties;

Guiding individual study, enrichment activities, and remedial work organized by the teacher;

Setting up AV equipment;

Assisting in drill work;

Helping with reading and storytelling;

Accompanying groups on field trips; and

Assisting in general non-instructional duties, such as snack, toilet, and recess routines.
