

INSTRUCTIONAL TELEVISION

The Committee recognizes that instructional and commercial television may potentially provide learning opportunities for students. Therefore, teachers are encouraged to consider the use of this resource whenever appropriate.

To assure that students receive the full benefit of televised instruction, teachers should:

Prepare the class by establishing the purpose of the activity and supplying needed background information;

Observe students during the telecast;

Follow-up immediately after the broadcast by clarifying or extending the topic; and

Use the telecast as a springboard for further learning activities.
