PUBLIC SOLICITATIONS IN SCHOOLS

The Kittery School Committee, acting with full realization of the many worthy causes of various local, state and federal organizations requesting student solicitation, prohibits soliciting of students.

Neither school time nor school funds will be devoted to the planning of or participation in non-school sponsored trips and activities. This is not intended to prevent civic, fraternal, or church groups from the use of the building facilities as currently provided in School Committee policy.

Students will not be required to be the carriers of notices, flyers, or advertisements of a non-official school nature. Materials other than this kind that the principals feel may be beneficial to the students may be available on a voluntary basis.

Verbal announcements for cancellations of meetings or date changes from non-commercial organizations that directly involve students may be made in the various schools.

Notices may be placed on the bulletin boards within the various schools by civic, fraternal, and church groups regarding meetings that involve public school students, with approval of the building principal.

Any requested for fund-raising activities by groups wishing to sell within the school or to solicit contributions should be referred to the School Committee through the Superintendent.
